

The McKeon Scholarship, established in memory of Larry McKeon in 2009. Larry McKeon served as a member of the Illinois House of Representatives from 1997 to 2007. He was the first openly gay member of the Illinois General Assembly and was also HIV-positive. The scholarship is awarded on the basis of academic performance, volunteerism, and political activism.
